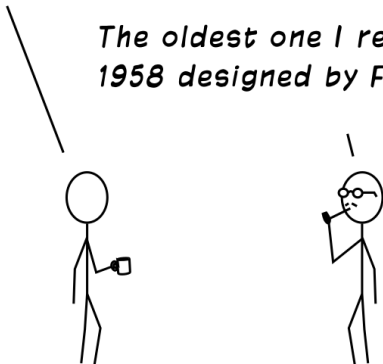


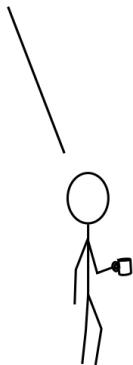
Artificial Intelligence is not new

such as the Roman empire.*

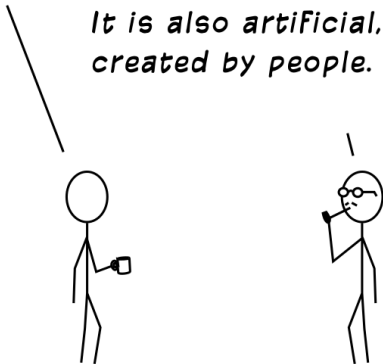

A government collects information into archives and makes decisions based on this information.

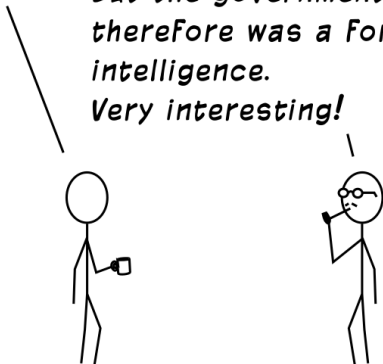
So a government can learn and adapt and is therefore intelligent. It is also artificial, because it is created by people.

Very interesting!



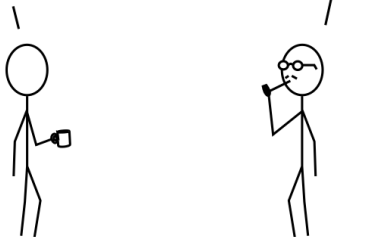
In a way we worship it as a god, since we trust and believe it.

True! We even Follow specific rituals bestowed by it in the Form of bureaucracy



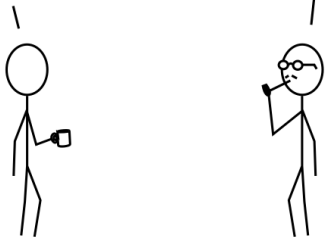
Jupiter was considered to be the patron deity of the Roman state, in charge of laws and social order.

Jupiter himself?*

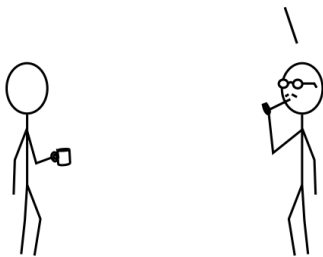


I guess artificial intelligence is nothing new

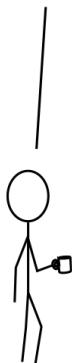
*Except that the digital automation
